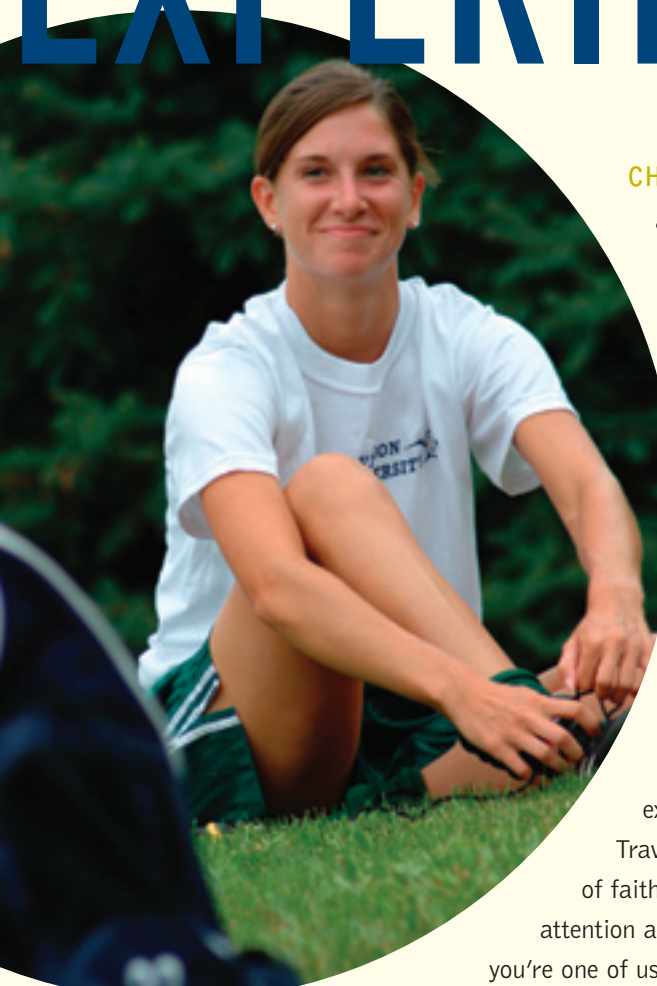

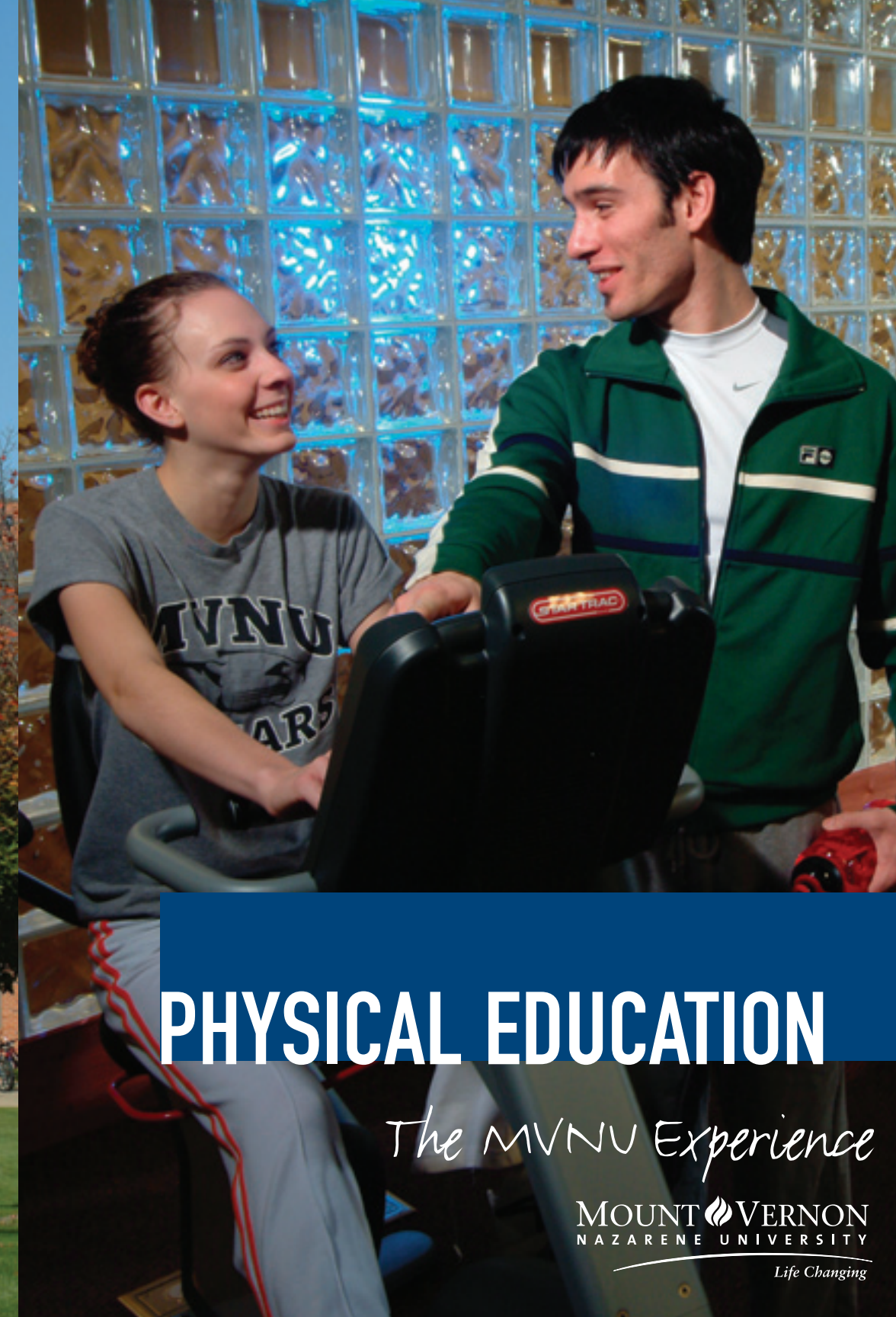

- Have the opportunity to master the knowledge and skills to work in school, community, camp, fitness, and recreational programs or in sports management settings, and
- Be equipped to promote dynamic health and recreation and a wholesome attitude toward physical fitness.

If your goal is to teach, our physical education programs not only meet licensure requirements for Ohio and many other states, but you will also gain practical experience teaching physical education and health in pre-school through secondary school environments through field experiences every semester you attend MVNU.

You will also gain practical knowledge in statistics, game management, and organizational techniques through our intercollegiate and intramural programs and have access to internships to give you on the job skills in sports organizations.
